

1st Year Confirmation Make Up Work

-Discuss the following questions with your parent.

-Write a 1-page essay that includes your answers to the following questions and any insights you gained during your discussions with your parent.

-What are some images (or "symbols") traditionally related to the Holy Spirit? What do they teach us about him? (See CCC 694-701)

-Deacon Burke-Sivers says the Holy Spirit can come in powerful or subtle ways. What are some of the quiet ways we can experience him in our lives?

-What are some ways that you think the Holy Spirit "animates" the Church?

-How does the Holy Spirit act as our "map"? What are some ways we can "access" that map?

-Which Person of the Blessed Trinity do you find it easiest to talk to? (Leader note: Remember, God is "one," so any time we pray to God, all three Persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit- hear our prayers.)

-When might you choose to pray directly to the Holy Spirit? (Leader note: Hint: What does the Holy Spirit do for us? Next class we will go over the 7 Gifts of the Holy Spirit)
